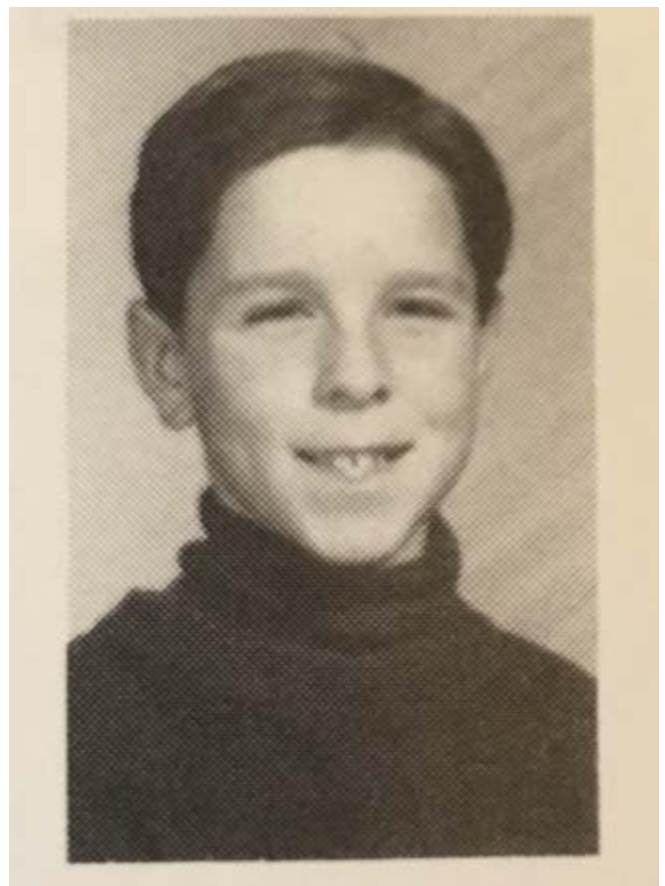
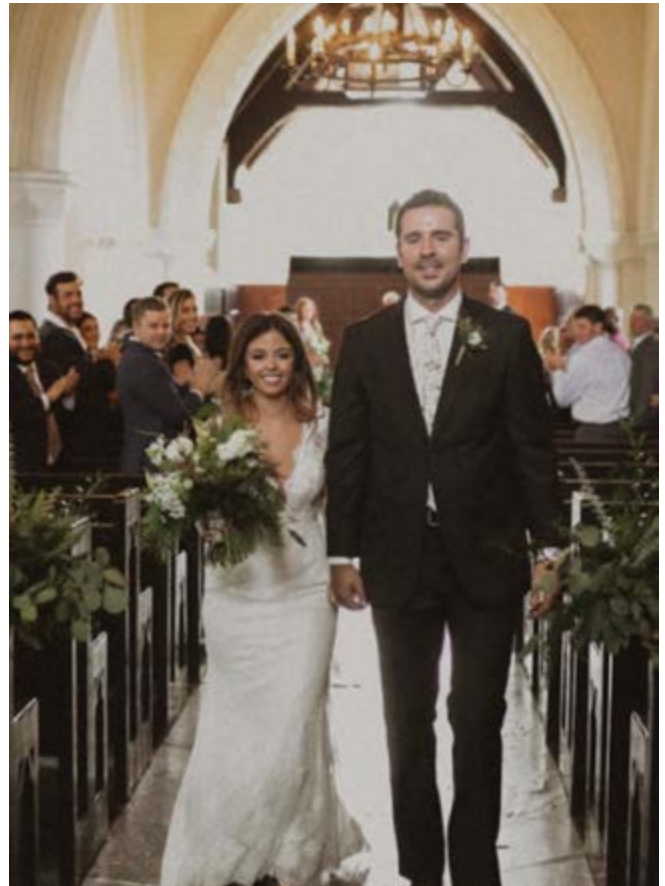

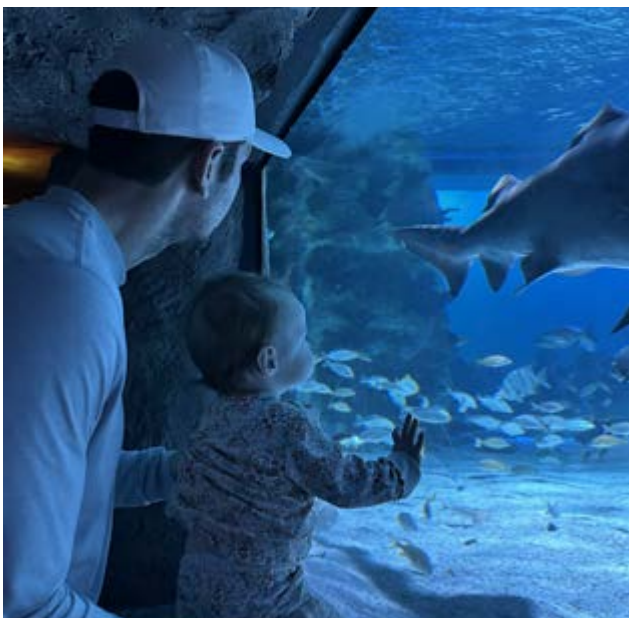
in Kiki's words...
